14 days tour to Shanghai, Suzhou

Day 1 Australia - Shanghai

Depart on your flight to Shanghai. Shanghai, one of the largest cities in China where east meets the west. Transfer to hotel. Overnight in Shanghai.

Day 2 Shanghai Meal: B/L

After breakfast, the day begins with a grand city tour of Shanghai - the classical Ming Dynasty Yu Yuan Gardens with pavilions, towers and terraces and Pudong, the new economic district across from the Bund. The tour continues after lunch with a stroll along the spacious promenade of the Bund and some window shopping along bustling Nanjing Road; then followed by a visit to Xintiandi, where "yesterday meets tomorrow in Shanghai today." As a re-creation born out of the sprawls of Shikumen housing, which is the architectural symbol of Shanghai in the 20th century, Shanghai Xintiandi, "the City's Living-room" is a place to unwind and relax after a long day. You can enjoy your shopping at the local market.

Day 3 Shanghai - Suzhou Meal: B/L

Today you take a day excursion to Suzhou. Suzhou, referred to as the "Venice of the East" because it was built around a network of canals and bridges which fan out from the Grand Canal. Suzhou is also famous for its charming gardens. Visit the picturesque Humble Administrator's Garden, the most famous garden in Suzhou, then visit Panmen Gate and see the Grand Canal, followed by a stop at the Number One Silk Factory to witness the production of the finest silk in China. Late afternoon, board your coach back to Shanghai. Overnight in Shanghai.



Day 4 Shanghai - Yichang Meal: B/D

This morning, you are transferred to the train station and take high speed train to Beijing. It takes around 5 hours to Beijing, the capital of China. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel. Overnight in Beijing.

Day 11 Beijing Meal: B/L

Today's visit includes Tiananmen Square, the largest city square in the world. From Tiananmen Square enter the Forbidden City. This massive complex was the centre of the Ming and Qing dynasties. With almost 10,000 rooms, this well-preserved imperial palace is the largest in the world. After lunch, you willvisit the Temple of Heaven, where emperors of the Ming and Qing dynasties would make offerings to heaven and pray for good harvests.

Day 12 Beijing Meal: B/L

Today you experience the splendor of the Great Wall, the pride of China and one of the Seven Wonders of the World. It is an amazing manmade structure built over 2000 years ago to protect China from northern invaders. In the afternoon visit Summer Palace, the largest and best preserved of all imperial palace gardens. Be amazed with fascination at the Marble Boat and the ornately painted Long Corridor.

This morning is at leisure. Subject to hotel check out policy. In time, transfer to the airport for your flight home bound.

13 day tour to Lanzhou, Jiayuguan Pass, Dunhuang, Turpan, Urumqi & Kashgar

Day 1 Australia - Guangzhou

Guangzhou, overnight on flight.

Day 2 Guangzhou - Lanzhou

Arrive Guangzhou in the morning then take connecting flight to Lanzhou. Upon arrival meet and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day is at leisure.

Day 3 Lanzhou - Bingningsi Temple Meal: B/L/D

Day trip to Bingningsi Temple. The Binglingsi Temple is a series of grottoes filled with Buddhist sculpture carved into natural caves and caverns in a canyon along the Yellow River. You take boat ride to reach the grottoes via the Liujiaxia Reservoir. Return to the city and visit the Yellow River and the city, including the Waterwheel Park.

Day 4 Lanzhou - Jiayuguan Pass Meal: B/L/D

In the morning board the high-speed train to Jiayuguan Pass (4.15Hrs), which is the western end of the Great Wall of China. Start your tour to the Jiayuguan Fortress, an impenetrable fortress surrounded by 3 inner and outer walls and several lines of defense; then visit Jiayuguan Fort, Great Wall Museum and Xuanbi Great Wall.

Day 5 Jiayuguan - Dunhuang Meal: B/L/D

Tower of the Great Wall before we travel by coach to Dunhuang (takes around 5 hours), a strategic staging post on the Silk Road with a history of more than 2,000 years. Upon arrival Dunhuang, short local visit if time permits. In the evening explore night market.

The walls of the caves are lined with Buddhist frescoes, Scriptures, murals, and sculpted figures; you also visit Mingsha Hill and Crescent Moon Lake set in an amphitheater of sand dunes. Dinner at own choice and expense

Day 7 Dunhuang - Turpan Meal: B/D

This morning is at leisure. At noon take high speed train from Liuyuan to Turpan (approx. 3.5 hours). Turpan, the oasis town famous for its melons and vineyards, is in the Gobi Desert and the lowest city in China as well as the driest and hottest. Upon arrival met and transferred to the hotel after dinner.

Day 8 Turpan - Urumqi Meal: B/L/D

Today you will visit Bezeklik Thousand Buddha Caves, then followed by Flaming Mountain Grand Canyon, which condenses the essence of the landscape of Flaming Mountain - the hottest spot in Turpan. Then to the bazaar and experience the atmosphere of the Uygur way of life. After lunch head to the ancient city of Jiaohe and Karez Well. The Karez Well is an underground irrigation system unique to the area. Drive to Urumqi in the late afternoon.

Day 9 Urumgi Meal: B/L/D

In the morning visit the First Beacon This morning you cruise on Heavenly Lake (Tianchi), a deep blue lake surrounded by the snowcapped Heavenly Mountain (Tianshan), followed by a visit to Red Hill Park which is regarded as the symbol of Urumqi then enjoy a leisure stroll at Erdaoquiao Grand Bazaar, if time permits visit the







Museum of Minorities and History. (Cruise on Heavenly Lake is not available from Nov. to Apr.)

Day 10 Urumqi - Kashgar Meal: B/D Fly to Kashgar this morning. Kashgar is an ancient oasis city at a strategic point dominating the ancient trade routes in far western China. You visit the Abak Hoja (Fragrant Concubine) Tomb, a local village and the Sunday Bazaar. You spend two nights in Kashgar.

Day 11 Kashgar – Karakuli Lake Meal: B/L Spend the entire day enjoying the beauty of the clear Karakuli Lake, whose color ranges from a dark green to azure and light blue. The lake lies at an altitude of 3,600m, and is the highest lake of the Pamir plateau, near the junction of the Pamir, Tian Shan, and Kunlun Mountain ranges. Surrounded by mountains which remain snow-covered throughout the year. Dinner at own choice and expense

Day 12 Kashgar - Guangzhou Meal: B Today you will fly from Kashgar to Guangzhou; upon arrival Guangzhou Airport, please make your own way to check in at the airport hotel which is next to the terminal.

Day 13 Guangzhou - Australia Meal: B This morning, please make your own way to check in your morning flight bound for Australia.

Northern China is not only rich in cultural heritage but also famous for its beautiful natural scenery. This carefully chosen itinerary takes you to the main cities starting from Dalian to the 'Ice City' of Harbin, home of "Harbin Ice & Snow Festival", ensuring an unforgettable tour. Day 1 Australia - Dalian

Depart Australia to Dalian via Shanghai or Guangzhou. Upon arrival you are met and transferred to your hotel for two nights.

Today's city tour in Dalian includes Binhai seaside Road, 100-year city statues, Tiger Beach Scenic Area, North Bridge, and the city squares. After dinner, you visit the largest light square in China - Xinhai Square to enjoy the night view of the city.



Day 7 Xian - Shanghai Meal: B

Then visit the new district across from the Bund called Pudong to experience the economy booming in China. We also take you to the Shanghai Tower to have the bird's eye view of the city. 


