Day 1 Sat Arrival Taipei

Upon arrival, you are met and transferred to hotel. Overnight in Taipei.

Day 2 Sun Taipei City Tour MEAL: B

After breakfast, we will take a classic Taipei day tour to explore the city's iconic historic landmarks and the modern tourist spots. On this tour, you will visit the world-renowned National Palace Museum that houses the largest collection of ancient Chinese artifacts in the world, where the exquisite art pieces will blow your mind; Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall, a prominent monument that symbolizes a significant period of Taiwan's history; Lungshan Temple that represents the local religious beliefs and practices; and the famous skyscraper, Taipei 101, that showcases the modern technology and globalization of the city. Of course, there are more to discover that you will just need come to find out. This guided tour unveils the past, present and future of Taipei City. With the help of your tour guide, you will learn more about each attraction that you visit during the tour and discover the city from a different perspective. Overnight at Taipei.

Day 3 Mon Taipei - Sun Moon Lake

MEAL: B

Today we will drive to Sun Moon Lake which is in the middle of Taiwan and situated 762 meters above sea level in the lofty mountains of Central Taiwan. Tour will stop at the famous Wenwu Temple, also known as Literature-Warrior Temple, dedicated to Confucius as Master of Pen and to Kuan Ti as Master of Sword, Holy Monk Shrine and Ci En Pagoda. After touring round Sun Moon Lake, check in hotel. Enjoy natural hot spring at the Fleur de Chine Hotel, Sun Moon Lake. You can also enjoy the walking trails, biking, hiking, or boating at the lake. Overnight in Sun Moon Lake.



Day 4 Tue Sun Moon Lake - Foguangshan Monastery - Kaohsiung

MEAL: B

Check out hotel Your journey continues at Fort Zeelandia, built by the Dutch East India Company during their 38-year rule in Taiwan. Nearly destroyed by the British in the 19th century, it was later restored by the Japanese. Next, stroll along Anping Old Street, Taiwan's first named street, rich in history and famous for local delicacies like tofu pudding and shrimp rolls. After lunch, visit the bustling city of Kaohsiung. Explore Fo Guang Shan Monastery, home to the towering 36-meter Buddha Amitabha statue. A monk will offer insights into Buddhism, Taiwan's most practiced religion. Overnight in Kaohsiung.





Day 5 Wed Kaohsiungv Kenting - Chipen Hot Springs, Taitung MEAL: B

After a hearty breakfast, head south to Kenting National Park, Taiwan’s first national park, known for its stunning coastal formations, diverse marine life, and tropical climate—a haven for surfers and divers. On day three of your Taiwan tour, visit Maopitou (Cat’s Nose), a rock formation resembling a crouching cat, and Chuanfan Rock, which resembles either a ship’s sail or former U.S. President Richard Nixon. Explore the Eluanbi Lighthouse, a Qing Dynasty relic and one of Taiwan’s Eight Views, and take in the panoramic ocean views at Longpan Park. After exploring Kenting, drive along the scenic South Link Highway to Taitung. Spend the night in Zhiben, famous for its hot springs. Relax at Hotel Royal Chihpen, where the soothing carbonate springs are perfect for unwinding after a day of adventure. Enjoy natural hot spring at Hotel Royal Chihpen (Zhiben Hot Springs).

Day 6 Thu Taitung - East Coast National Scenic Area - Hualien - Yilan MEAL: B

After a restful night and a delicious breakfast, your Taiwan tour continues along the pristine east coast, celebrated for its untouched natural beauty. You’ll visit some of the region’s most breathtaking spots, each showcasing unique geological wonders: Xiaoyeliu, Sanxiantai, Shitiping, and Fanshuliao. Start at Xiaoyeliu (Fugang Geopark), where striking rock formations, shaped by sea erosion, resemble those at Yehliu in northern Taiwan. Next, explore Sanxiantai, featuring an offshore island connected by a striking cross-sea bridge, a landmark of the East Coast National Scenic Area. Continue to Shitiping, a dramatic sea erosion terrace with cliffs, sea grooves, and potholes formed over millions of years, making it a fascinating geological site. To wrap up the day, enjoy a comfortable train ride from Hualien to Yilan, taking in the scenic views along the way. Overnight in Yilan.

Day 7 Fri Yilan - Taipei MEAL: B

After a hotel breakfast, begin with a visit to the King Car Kavalan Whisky Distillery, renowned globally for its award-winning whiskies made from the pristine waters of the Central and Xueshan Mountain Ranges. Enjoy the rich aromas and distinct flavours as you explore the distillery. Next, head to the National Centre for Traditional Arts, where you can immerse yourself in Taiwanese culture through exhibitions, performances, and hands-on workshops. Explore traditional buildings, watch puppet shows, or try pottery making, experiencing Taiwan’s cultural heritage firsthand. Conclude your unforgettable journey with a bus ride back to Taipei City, Check in your hotel in Taipei for 2 nights.

Day 8 Sat Taipei - Full Day Yehliu, Jiufen Village and Pingxi Tour MEAL: B

After breakfast, we discover the unique charm of the rural districts along the north and northeast coast of Taiwan. Visit Jiufen Village, a hillside village prosperous in the 1940s that will bring you an old-time vibe with its atmospheric alleys; Yehliu Geopark, known for its unique coastal erosion features, will blow you mind away; Pingxi District, a former mining town that is known for the world-famous "Pingxi Sky Lantern Festival", where you will experience the iconic tradition of flying sky lantern and visit the “Little Niagara Falls” of Taiwan—Shifen Waterfall. Whether you are a first-timer or a repeat visitor, you will fully enjoy what Taiwan’s north and northeast.

This morning is at leisure. Transfer to airport for your flight home bound.

8-day Tour to Ulaanbaatar, Elsen Tasarkhai, Karakorum, Hustai with Naadam Festival

Naadam Festival, the biggest festival in Mongolia. In the opening ceremony of the Naadam Festival, we will cheer on the dancers, athletes, wrestlers, archers, horse riders and musicians. Tour around Ulaanbaatar city, wander on the grassland, sleep in traditional Gers, devour Mongolian barbecue in the grasslands, what a joy and experience of Mongolia!

Day 1 06 Jul 2025 Arrival Ulaanbaatar Meal: D
Upon arrival Ulaanbaatar, the capital of Mongolia. You are met at the airport after custom formalities and transferred to your hotel. The remainder of the day is at leisure. Check in at 4* Holiday Inn for 1 night.


Day 2 07 Jul Ulaanbaatar - Elsen Tasarkhai - Karakorum Meal: B/L/D
After breakfast at the hotel, we depart to the west toward Karakorum, the ancient capital city of Mongolia, at 8 am. Break our drive at the Elsen Tasarkhai, aka Bayangobi sand dunes, around lunch time. Enjoy lunch then visit the Khugnu Khan Nature Reserve and Erdene Khamba monastery ruins. We also do 1-hr camel riding in the afternoon. Continue our drive to Karakorum in the evening and arrive before dinnertime. Check into your accommodation and enjoy dinner. Stay at Urgoo Ger Camp or similar.

Day 3 08 Jul Karakorum Meal: B/L/D
In the morning, we will visit legendary monastery Erdene Zuu, the first Buddhist monastery of Central Mongolia, founded in 1586, and its surroundings such as the Turtle Rock and the Phallic stone etc. In the afternoon we will visit the Museum of Karakorum which gives a good introduction to Central Mongolia, its' history and the UNESCO world heritage site Orkhon river valley. In the evening, pay a visit to the newly established Erdenesiin Khuree calligraphy center (workshop available for extra cost, paid on spot by the client if wishes to attend). Stay at Urgoo Ger Camp or similar

Day 4 09 Jul Karakorum - Hustai National Park Meal: B/L/D
This morning, we drive back towards Ulaanbaatar; arrive at our camp after few hours' drives. Check in and enjoy lunch. In the afternoon, we will take a short drive to one of the most popular national parks of Mongolia, the Hustai National Park. We will trek through the beautiful national park and try to view the endangered Przewalski wild horses (one of the last remaining wild horses. We will do 1 hour horseback riding in the rolling green hills of Mongolian steppe. Stay at Mongal Nomadic Ger or similar.

Day 5 10 Jul Hustai - Ulaanbaatar Meal: B/L
After breakfast, we will drive to the Naadam Festival horseracing venue and witness the horseraces. Afterwards, continue to UB, and arrive in town in the early afternoon. Visit the Central stadium where the archery & anklebone shooting competitions are held and see the most important competitions in the country for these sports. Dinner is independent and overnight at Holiday Inn or similar.

Day 6 11 Jul Naadam Festival Meal: B/L/D

See the fantastic opening ceremony of Naadam festival in the central stadium where the president of Mongolia opens the ceremony, followed by 1.5 hr of entertainment, and the first round of wrestling match. After lunch, we will visit the Central Square of Ulaanbaatar, named after a hero of Mongolian people's revolution in 1921, Sukhbaatar D. We will also visit the newly established Chinggis Khaan Museum, and then see a traditional cultural performance by the Tumen Ekh ensemble. Enjoy a farewell dinner with your travel companions.

Day 7 12 Jul Ulaanbaatar Meal: B

Today is at leisure; you can explore more of the city at your own pace.

Day 8 13 Jul Ulaanbaatar departure Meal: B

This morning is at leisure until you are transferred to the airport for your flight home bound.



The Gobi Desert & Karakorum Beyond Tour

11-day Tour to Ulaanbaatar, Tsagaan Suvarga, Khongor Sand Dunes, the Flaming Cliffs, Karakorum & Hustai National Park

Day 1 Arrival Ulaanbaatar

Upon arrival Ulaanbaatar, the capital of Mongolia. You are met at the airport and transferred to check in your hotel.

Day 2 Ulaanbaatar City Tour

Meal: B/L

In the morning start at Gandan Monastery, home to the 26-meter statue of Janraisag, the deity of compassion, and attend the morning chanting at one of the old temples. Next, visit Sukhbaatar Square, where you'll see statues of Chinggis Khaan and his descendants in front of the State House. In the afternoon, explore the newly established Chinggis Khaan Museum, offering an overview of Mongolia's history, from the Hunnu Empire to the Great Mongol Empire.

Day 3 Ulaanbaatar – Tsagaan Suvarga Meal: B/L/D

Today's expedition leads us to Tsagaan Suvarga, a remarkable sedimentary formation that harks back to an ancient seabed. Our journey spans approximately 6-7 hours, punctuated by a refreshing lunch break in Mandagovi town. Upon arrival at the camp, you'll check in and settle in for a rewarding adventure. We'll embark on an excursion to the Tsagaan Suvarga scarps, where you can revel in a captivating hike amidst the vibrant cliffs, ascending toward the summit for breathtaking views. Stay at Tsagaan Suvarga Camp or similar.

Day 4 Tsagaan Suvarga- Yolyn Am (Lammergeier Valley), Gurvan Saikhan National Park Meal: B/L/D

Today, we embark on a picturesque journey to Gobi Gurvan Saikhan National Park, a drive that spans approximately four to five hours, allowing us ample opportunities for scenic photography stops. Our expedition includes a pit stop in Dalanzadgad, a charming Gobi town, where we'll explore the newly constructed Umnugovi province museum and savor a

delightful lunch. Following our visit to Dalanzadgad, we'll embark on a brief drive to reach the enchanting Yolyn Am. Here, you'll have the opportunity to partake in a one-hour hike from our parking spot, immersing yourself in the breath-taking natural beauty. Eventually, we'll transfer to ger camp - stay at Gobi Mirage Camp or similar.

Day 5 Khongor sand dunes, Camel ride Meal: B/L/D

After breakfast, we'll drive 4-5 hours to Mongolia's Khongor sand dunes, the longest in the country. The journey through vast desert badlands is lined with remote mountains, scattered gers, and nomads traveling by camel or horseback. The rugged Gobi landscape, dotted with colorful rocks and minerals, offers countless photo opportunities. On arrival, we'll explore the stunning dunes by the Khongor river, with an optional camel ride. The day concludes with a cozy dinner and stay at Gobi Erdene.

Day 6 Khavtsgait Petroglyph and Bayanzag, The Flaming Cliffs Meal: B/L/D

This morning, we'll drive to Gobi Gurvan Saikhan park, stopping at the Khavtsgait Petroglyph in Dund Saikhan Mountain to explore Bronze Age rock paintings. Continuing north, we reach Bayanzag, the famous Flaming Cliffs. At the information center, we'll enjoy exhibits and a short documentary before hiking along a scenic trail through unique formations. We'll return to camp in the evening for dinner and an overnight stay at Gobi Tour Camp or similar.

Day 7 Ongi Monastery Meal: B/L/D

After breakfast, we'll drive north for about 4-5 hours across the vast Ongi steppe to the scenic Ongi Monastery ruins by the Ongi River. Upon arrival at our ger camp, we'll have

lunch, followed by an afternoon exploring the 18th-century monastery ruins with a short hike. We'll then return to the camp to relax, enjoy dinner, and spend a peaceful night in this tranquil setting. Stay at Secret of Ongi camp.

Day 8 Ongi Monastery – Karakorum Meal: B/L/D

Today, we journey north into central Mongolia with a scenic 4–5-hour drive across the Gobi steppes, stopping for lunch along the highway to the western province. After lunch, we'll continue for another 1–2 hours, possibly visiting a nomadic family en route, before arriving in Karakorum. Here, we'll explore the Karakorum Museum and learn about the history of Central Mongolia and the UNESCO-listed Orkhon River Valley. We'll check into Urguu Camp, enjoy dinner, and settle in for a restful overnight stay.

Day 9 Hustai National Park Meal: B/L/D

After breakfast, we'll visit the historic Erdene Zuu Monastery, founded in 1586 as Central Mongolia's first Buddhist monastery. Next, we'll head to Hustai National Park, stopping at Elsen Tasarkhai and having lunch at a roadside restaurant. Upon arrival in Hustai, we'll explore the park, looking out for Takhi wild horses and other wildlife in their natural habitat. We'll then head to our ger camp Mongol Nomadic for a hearty dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 10 Ulaanbaatar Meal: B/L/D

Check out from our camp and travel to Ulaanbaatar with 2–3-hour drive. Arrive in Ulaanbaatar and start our city sightseeing tour. Your journey begins with a visit to the Natural History Museum for the natural insight of Mongolia. Transfer to the hotel for check in followed by a lunch at local restaurant. If time permits, you can engage in some optional shopping for cashmere and souvenirs. As the day draws to a close, immerse yourself in Mongolia's rich cultural heritage with a traditional folklore concert at the Tumen Ekh ensemble. The day concludes with a heartfelt farewell dinner, a fitting way to celebrate the end of your journey.

Day 11 Ulaanbaatar departure Meal: B

Transfer to the airport for your flight home bound.

Day 1 Arrival Seoul

Upon arrival at Incheon Airport, met and transferred to check in your hotel. You stay in Seoul for 3 nights.

Day 2 Seoul Traditional Highlights Meal: B

Today you will take seat in coach group tour. Drive by Gwanghwamun City Hall and attend the changing of the guard's ceremony at 9 am. Then visit the palace Gyeongbokgung, first palace of the king of the Joseon dynasty. Built in 1395, Gyeongbokgung Palace is the most beautiful, and remains the largest of all five palaces. Inside is the National Palace Museum, relating the history of the Joseon Dynasty and the National Folk Museum. (Open every day except Tuesdays). You will drive by the Presidential Blue House. In the afternoon, you will visit Chandeok Palace, Ginseng Centre, then following by walking through the traditional Seoul district, Insadong, famous for his antique streets, tea rooms and small craft shops and Namdaemun Market. Return to your hotel.

Day 3 Full day DMZ Tour Meal: B

Enjoy a full day group SIC tour to DMZ (closed on Mon and National holidays)

The Demilitarized Zone (DMZ) is a buffer zone, which was established in 1953 when the Armistice Agreement was signed during the Korean War. The DMZ vividly captures the scars and wounds of the Korean War as well as the wishes and hopes for the future. Visiting route: Hotel - Imjingak Park - Freedom Bridge - The 3rd infiltration Tunnel - DMZ Theater/ Exhibition Hall - Dora observatory - Dorasan Station - Unification Village (Pass by)- Back to Seoul and drop off at City Hall.

In case cancellation, alternative tour course will be provided, and it is not refundable. Alternative tour route: Hotel - Imjingak Park - Freedom Bridge - Peace Gondola - Odu Unification Observatory (can see the North Korea at here) - City Hall

The DMZ tour typically concludes between 2:00 PM and 6:00 PM. Due to the unique characteristics of the DMZ, there are strict limitations on the number of visitors allowed to enter each hour. As a result, even if you arrive early, it is challenging to predict the exact duration of the tour. Please take this into account when planning your schedule.


